



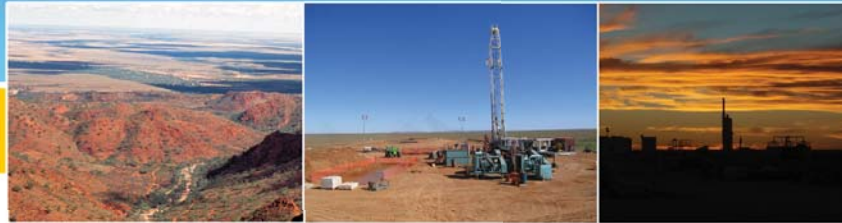

**The 2nd Annual Australian Geothermal Energy Conference and Trade Show
Hilton Brisbane on 10-13 November 2009**

The official geothermal conference

This is the official conference of the Australian geothermal industry, and the only one supported by the Australian Geothermal Energy Association (AGEA), the Australian Geothermal Energy Group (AGEG) and Australian geothermal energy companies.

It will be low cost (less than \$1,000/person registration fee for a three day event) and will include a geothermal trade show, unique to this event. This conference builds on last year's highly successful inaugural meeting, which attracted about 300 attendees.

The Australian Geothermal Energy Conference will feature keynote addresses from international and domestic leaders in the geothermal exploration and development sector, plus speakers from government, academia and research institutes. We will cover issues of science, technology, policy and finance. This conference is being run in liaison with the NZ Geothermal Workshop to be held the following week, 16th-18th November, in Auckland, New Zealand.

Conference Structure and Themes

A pre-conference Workshop will be held on Tuesday 10 November and will be conducted by the Institute of Earth Science & Engineering from the University of Auckland.

Day One, Wednesday 11 November, has investors and financiers in mind and will provide an update of latest developments nationally and internationally and will feature presentations from all leading Australian geothermal energy companies, including Geodynamics, Petratherm, Green Rock, Torrens, Panax, KUTh and Greenerth.

This day can be attended separately for those interested only in the comprehensive company presentations.

Days Two and Three, 12 and 13 November, are more technical and policy in nature and will provide concurrent sessions covering geothermal energy exploration, evaluation and development, under the key themes of:

- ❖ 'Exploration'
- ❖ 'Underground Science & Technology'
- ❖ 'Direct Use'
- ❖ 'Power Conversion Technologies'
- ❖ 'Legislation, Policy and Infrastructure'
- ❖ 'Finance Panel (Raising capital in difficult times)'
