INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS

Recreational rock lobster pots may only be used by the registration holder. Only one registration can be issued per person, with a maximum of two pots per registration.

Payment Methods:

1. POSTED (payment by cheque or credit card), to PIRSA, Fisheries, PO Box 282, PORT ADELAIDE SA 5015. Cheques made payable to PIRSA.
2. In PERSON (payment by cash, cheque, EFTPOS and credit card) at PIRSA offices located at Birkenhead, Port Lincoln, Streaky Bay, Mount Gambier, Kadina, Loxton, Struan, Kingscote, Murray Bridge and 14th Floor, 25 Grenfell St, Adelaide.

INSTRUCTIONS TO POT REGISTRATION HOLDERS

You must have a valid rock lobster pot registration (and valid tags fitted to each pot) before you can use a rock lobster pot in South Australian waters.

A numbered tag issued by PIRSA **MUST BE** attached to the top of the rope near the red floating buoy, so that it is visible above the surface of the water, when the pot is in use. In the case of a lost or stolen tag, you will be required to apply to PIRSA Fisheries for a replacement tag to be issued. Applications for replacement tags can be made in person at a PIRSA Fisheries office or by telephoning PIRSA Fisheries Licensing on (08) 8347 6107 to request a form. A fee of \$20.80 applies to the issue of replacement tags. Pots must be removed from the water until the replacement tag has been received and attached.

Upon processing of this application, you will be issued with a recreational rock lobster catch & effort return for the 2006/2007 fishing season. A unique number will link this return to each registration. At the end of the rock lobster fishing season, or on completion of your rock lobster fishing activity for the season, please complete your log sheet and return it to us. Fold the return, with the postal details outermost, secure the fold and place in the post. The information you provide on your sheet is valuable, and will be used in the management of the fishery.

Rock Lobster Fishing Seasons 2006/2007

Northern zone - is open from 12 noon 1 November 2006 to 6:00pm on 31 May 2007.

Southern zone - is open from 6:00am 1 October 2006 to 6:00pm 31 May 2007.
