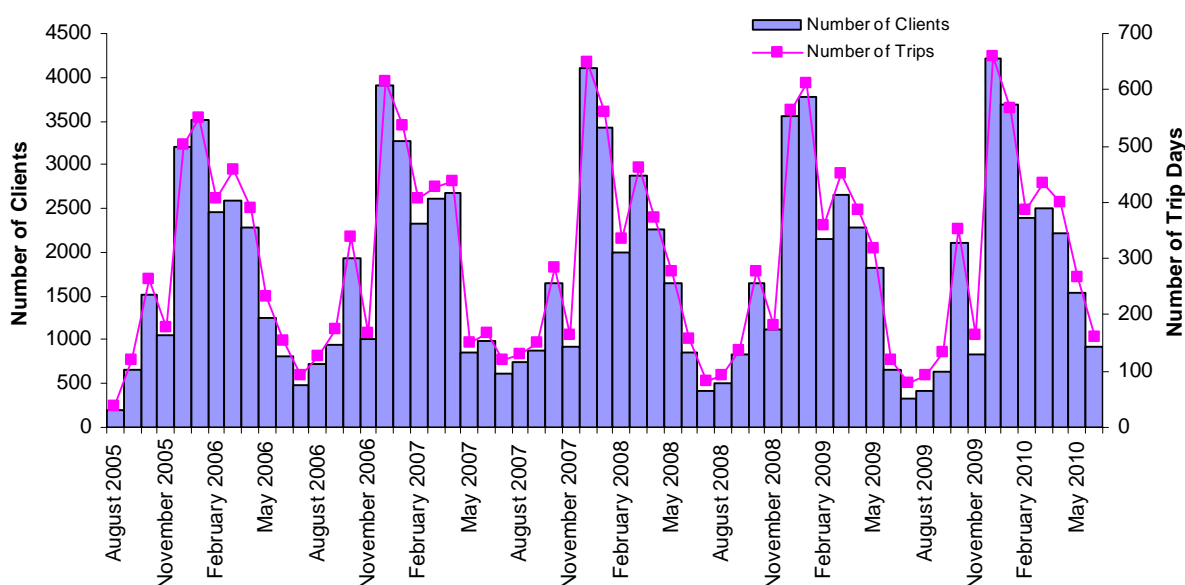


Figure 1: The number of charter boat clients and trip days per month

The Average Number of Trip Days per Month and the Average Number of Clients per Trip per Licence

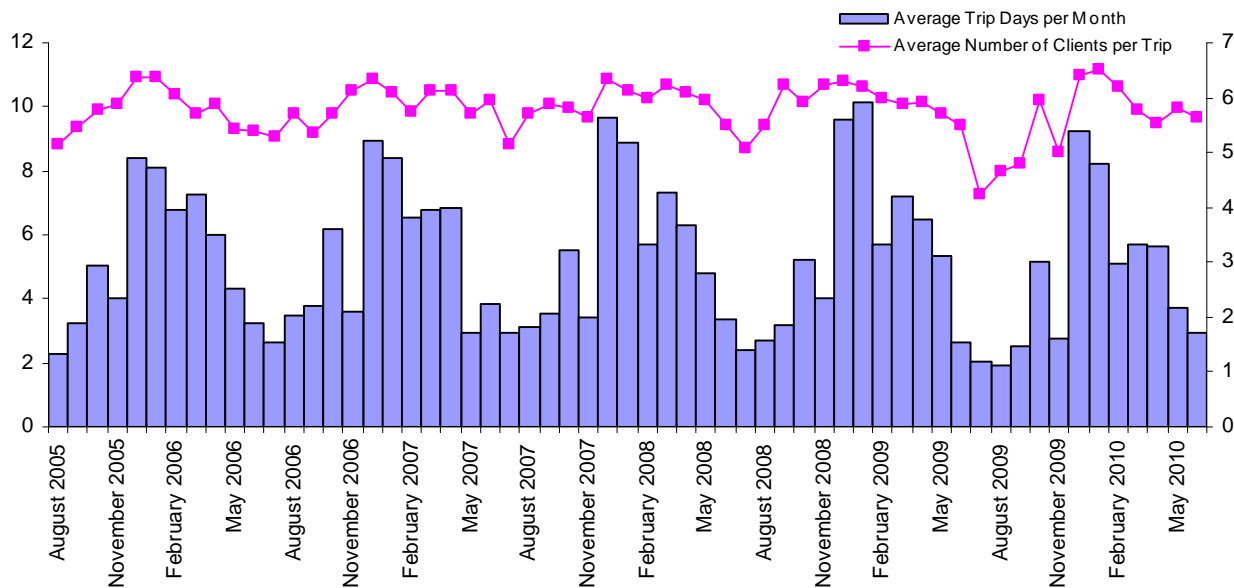


Figure 2: The average number of trip days per month and the average number of clients per trip per licence
