It's illegal to carry uncertified fruit and vegetables across all borders into South Australia

- Don't risk a fine or an on-the-spot penalty.
- Quarantine detector dogs operate at Adelaide Airport.
- Quarantine roadblocks and fruit disposal bins are strategically placed throughout South Australia.
- Mobile quarantine roadblocks operate on country roads in South Australia.
- Only fruit and vegetables purchased within South Australia may be taken into the SA Riverland, provided a valid shop receipt* or Plant Health Certificate accompanies it.

*Produce with receipts is not to be carried across State borders.
