Fisheries Management (Sardine Fishery) Regulations 2021

Regulation 11

For the purpose of regulation 11 relating to the information to be provided when certain registered boats used to take sardines – I make the following determination –

Regulation 11 – Information to be provided when certain registered boats used to take sardines

- (1) If a registered boat is used under more than 1 Sardine Fishery licence to take sardines under the licence, the Department must be informed by telephone on 1800 065 522 or by the Commercial Fishing SA Application at least 4 hours before the commencement of the fishing trip of
 - a. The number of the licence under which the boat is to be used; and
 - b. The name of the person who will be conducting the fishing activity; and
 - c. The previous licence number that was being used; and
 - d. The name of the vessel being used; and
 - e. The intended date of the boat's departure; and
 - f. The intended time of the boat's departure.
- (2) If a boat registered under more than 1 Sardine Fishery licence is used to take sardines on 2 or more consecutive occasions under the same Sardine Fishery licence, clause (1) need only be complied with in relation to the first occasion (i.e. until such time as the boat is to be used under a different Sardine Fishery Licence).
