## **GUIDE TO REGISTRATION AS A FISH PROCESSOR**

## **Definition of Fish Processing:**

The *Fisheries Management Act 2007* defines a fish processor as:

"a person who for the purpose of trade or business process, purchases or obtains fish."

and processing is defined as:

"scaling, gilling, gutting, filleting, freezing, chilling, packing or other activity involved in preparing fish for sale."

This means that any person who purchases, for the purpose of trade or business, from a licence holder must register as a fish processor.

#### NOTE:

Processors may vary assets during the year by making an application to the Minister. All application forms are available from:

It is an offence to use any assets in connection with processing fish unless the assets are specified on the certificate of registration.

BASE plus TWO MAJOR SPECIES - trade in scalefish and associated species and two other major species (either prawn and rock lobster, prawn abalone or rock lobster and abalone)	\$4633.00
BASE plus THREE MAJOR SPECIES - trade in scalefish and associated species and all three other major species (prawn, rock lobster and abalone)	\$6305.00
