Determination under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991*

I refer to your application made under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* (the Act) received by the Office of the Minister for Primary Industries and Regional Development and the Office of Minister for Forest Industries on 5 August 2022 requesting access to the following:

“A copy of all entries in the diary of the Minister for Primary Industries and Regional Development and the Minister for Forest Industries between 31 May 2022 and 31 July 2022”

As the information for 31 May 2022 and 1 June 2022 has been provided to you in response to a previous application received from you (refer MPIRD eA197412), these dates have been excluded from the scope of your application.

Accordingly, the following determination has been finalised.

I have located one document that is captured within the scope of your request.

Determination

I have determined that access to the following document is **granted in part**:

The information removed from the above document is pursuant to Clause 1(1)(e), Clause 6(1), Clause 7(1)(c), Clause 9(1) and Clause 13(1)(a) of Schedule 1 of the Freedom of Information Act.

Clause 1(1)(e) states:

“1 – Cabinet documents

- (1) A document is an exempt document –
(e) if it contains matter the disclosure of which would disclose information concerning any deliberation or decision of Cabinet;”*

The information removed pursuant to Clause 1(1)(e) would reveal detail of matters for consideration in Cabinet.

Clause 6(1) states:

“6 - Documents affecting personal affairs

- (1) A document is an exempt document if it contains matter the disclosure of which would involve the unreasonable disclosure of information concerning the personal affairs of any person (living or dead).”*

The information removed pursuant to Clause 6(1) consists of the following:

- Mobile and landline phone numbers
- Personal information relating to the Minister and other individuals

The term ‘personal affairs’ has been held to involve ‘matters of private concern to an individual’ and the ‘composite collection of activities personal to the individual concerned’.

Accordingly, it is considered that disclosure of this information would be an unreasonable intrusion into the privacy rights of the individuals concerned.

Clause 7(1)(c) states:

“7 – Documents affecting business affairs

- (1) A document is an exempt document –
(c) if it contains matter –
(i) consisting of information (other than trade secrets or information referred to in paragraph (b)) concerning the business, professional, commercial or financial affairs of any agency or any other person; and
(ii) the disclosure of which –
(A) could reasonably be expected to have an adverse effect on those affairs or to prejudice the future supply of such information to the Government or to an agency; and
(B) would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest”*

The information removed pursuant to Clause 7(1)(c) consists of the following:

- the names of individuals and organisations
- topics of discussion

In addressing the public interest test requirement for the Clause 7(1)(c) exemption, I have balanced the following factors:

In favour of the public interest:

- Meeting the objects of the Act favouring access to documents.
- Ensuring optimal use of public resources.
- High level of interest in the accountability of public office holders.
- The importance of transparency and openness and the interest that the public has in the decision-making processes of Government.

Contrary to the public interest:

- The need to preserve confidentiality of the names of individuals and organisations when undertaking business discussions.
- The recent age of the information was considered and the continuing relevance of the matters.
- If the information was released, organisations may be reluctant to transact with the Office of the Minister for fear of their identities being exposed.
- Disclosure of this information may compromise the manner in which information is recorded for the decision-making processes and transparency of Government.
- The release of this information would have the potential to harm business relationships with Government.

Having considered the various factors weighing for and against disclosure, I have determined that disclosure of this information would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest.

Clause 9(1) states:

“9—Internal working documents

(1) A document is an exempt document if it contains matter—

(a) that relates to -

(i) any opinion, advice or recommendation that has been obtained, prepared or recorded; or

(ii) any consultation or deliberation that has taken place, in the course of, or for the purpose of, the decision-making functions of the Government, a Minister or an agency; and

(b) the disclosure of which would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest.”

The information removed pursuant to Clause 9(1) consists of the topics of discussion for the decision-making purposes of a Minister.

In addressing the public interest test for the Clause 9(1) exemption, I have balanced the following factors:

In favour of the public interest:

- Meeting the objects of the Act favouring access to documents.
- Ensuring optimal use of public resources.
- High level of interest in the accountability of public office holders.
- The importance of transparency and openness and the interest that the public has in the decision-making processes of Government.

Contrary to the public interest:

- Topics of discussion are required to be recorded in the Minister's calendar, however, the confidentiality of some subjects must be maintained for decision-making purposes prior to being made public.
- The recent age of the information was considered and the continuing relevance of the matters.
- Disclosing this information may compromise the manner in which information is gathered in the future for the decision-making processes of Government.

Having considered the various factors weighing for and against disclosure, I have determined that disclosure of this information would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest.

Clause 13(1)(a) states:

“13 - Documents containing confidential material

(1) A document is an exempt document —

(a) if it contains matter the disclosure of which would found an action for breach of confidence;”

The material removed pursuant to Clause 13(1)(a) consists of details relating to Cabinet Committee meetings and is regarded as being confidential information which is not for release into the public domain.

If you are unhappy with this determination you are entitled to exercise your rights of external review with the Ombudsman SA. Alternatively, you can apply to the South Australian Civil and Administrative Tribunal (SACAT). If you wish to seek a review, you must do so within 30 calendar days of receiving this internal review determination.
