Accordingly, it is considered that disclosure of this information would be an unreasonable intrusion into the privacy rights of the individuals concerned.

The information removed from the above document is pursuant to Clause 6(1) and Clause 7(1)(c) of Schedule 1 of the Freedom of Information Act.

The information removed pursuant to Clause 6(1) consists of a name of a third party. Pursuant to Section 27 of the Freedom of Information Act, consultation was undertaken with the third party to which the document relates and consent was not provided to release this information.

Accordingly, it is considered that disclosure of this information would be an unreasonable intrusion into the privacy rights of the individual concerned.

Clause 7(1)(c) states:

***“7 – Documents affecting business affairs***

*(1) A document is an exempt document –*

*(c) if it contains matter –*

- (i) consisting of information (other than trade secrets or information referred to in paragraph (b)) concerning the business, professional, commercial or financial affairs of any agency or any other person; and*
- (ii) the disclosure of which –*
  - (A) could reasonably be expected to have an adverse effect on those affairs or to prejudice the future supply of such information to the Government or to an agency; and*
  - (B) would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest”*

The information removed pursuant to Clause 7(1)(c) consists of the business affairs of a company.

In addressing the public interest test requirement for the Clause 7(1)(c) exemption, I have balanced the following factors:

*In favour of the public interest:*

- Meeting the objects of the Act favouring access to documents.
- Ensuring optimal use of public resources.
- High level of interest in the accountability of public office holders.
- The importance of transparency and openness and the interest that the public has in the decision-making processes of Government.

*Contrary to the public interest:*

- Protecting the commercial and business interests of third parties.
- The recent age of the documents and the ongoing relevance of the matters was considered.
- Disclosure of this information would reveal detail which is considered commercially sensitive to the company concerned.
- There is an expectation by applicants to grant programs that information relating to their applications are considered commercial-in-confidence.
- In accordance with Government contract management policies and guidelines, information obtained in the course of assessment processes is required to be kept confidential for probity reasons.
- If third parties cannot be assured of confidentiality by Government with respect to their business affairs, this would have the potential to harm business relationships with Government and hamper future dealings with agencies for the betterment of South Australia.

- Disclosure of this information would be expected to prejudice the future supply of information to Government, as the level of trust in handling such information would be substantially diminished.

Having considered the various factors weighing for and against disclosure, I have determined that disclosure of this information would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest.

Access to the above documents is refused pursuant to Clause 7(1)(c) of Schedule 1 of the Freedom of Information Act.

The documents contain the financial and business affairs of companies.

In addressing the public interest test requirement for the Clause 7(1)(c) exemption, I have balanced the following factors:

#### *In favour of the public interest:*

- Meeting the objects of the Act favouring access to documents.
- Ensuring optimal use of public resources.
- High level of interest in the accountability of public office holders.
- The importance of transparency and openness and the interest that the public has in the decision-making processes of Government.

#### *Contrary to the public interest:*

- Protecting the commercial and business interests of third parties.
- The recent age of the documents and the ongoing relevance of the matters was considered.
- Disclosure of this information would reveal detail which is considered commercially sensitive to the company concerned.
- If third parties cannot be assured of confidentiality by Government with respect to communications relating to their commercially sensitive information, this would have the potential to harm business relationships with Government and hamper future dealings with agencies for the betterment of South Australia.
- Disclosure of this information would be expected to prejudice the future supply of information to Government, as the level of trust in handling such information would be substantially diminished.

Having considered the various factors weighing for and against disclosure, I have determined that disclosure of these documents would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest.

If you are unhappy with this determination you are entitled to exercise your rights of external review with the Ombudsman SA. Alternatively, you can apply to the South Australian Civil and Administrative Tribunal (SACAT). If you wish to seek a review, you must do so within 30 calendar days of receiving this internal review determination.

Thank you for your letter of 22 June 2022 regarding the suspension of **Clause 6(1)** and access to veterinary services in **Clause 6(1)** and surrounding areas. Your letter has been referred to me by the office of the Hon Andrea Michaels MP.

In South Australia the *Veterinary Practice Act 2003* (the Act) defines the process for investigating complaints about registered veterinary surgeons (vets), including the lodgement of complaints by the registrar of the Veterinary Surgeons Board of South Australia (VSBSA) with the South Australian Civil and Administrative Tribunal (SACAT). SACAT may take a number of actions including suspension of a vet's registration.

Following lodgement of a complaint by the VSBSA registrar SACAT has completed a hearing process and has disqualified **Clause 6(1)** permanently from practicing as a veterinary services provider.

I understand there are several vet clinics in the regional area in which **Clause 6(1)** was practising, offering a range of daytime and afterhours services, including:

**Clause 6(1)**

Furthermore, the **Clause 6(1)** Veterinary Services has recently increased their operating hours to service increased demand.

Once again, thank you for writing to me to raise your concerns about this matter and the availability of vet services in your region.

Thank you for your letter regarding the proposed CirPro Abattoir in Port Pirie.

As you are aware CirPro Abattoir, previously Pirie Meats, is seeking to establish a multi-faceted Advanced Processing Facility near Port Pirie. I note that the development would provide significant investment and jobs into Port Pirie and surrounding areas.

In March 2022, **Clause 6(1)** wrote to me summarising past grant applications and to provide a timeline of CirPro's engagement with the Government of South Australia.

## Golden North Dairies - Laura

Dear Minister Scriven *CLARE*

I would like to discuss with you the anticipated expansion of the Golden North facility, located in Laura, in the Southern Flinders Ranges. I will refer to ongoing conversations and correspondence with the previous State Government regarding this matter.

Golden North is an iconic brand and will celebrate 100 years as an ongoing business next year and are looking to expand their operation locally. This expansion will ensure employment for the existing workforce and provide opportunities for further employment prospects in the region.

Golden North was established by the Bowker family in 1923 and has had a turnover of ownership over that period and yet it continues to be a household name. It became a subsidiary of National Foods in 1991 and in 2001 a group of South Australian family investors bought the business; it is now back under local private ownership.

Prior to the State Election I was privileged to arrange a site inspection of the facility with the now Premier and Treasurer. The proposed expansion plans were discussed whilst we enjoyed a very welcome "Giant Twin" ice cream.

The discussion included the process of which the owners are to submit a detailed proposal for the anticipated works and to include a project plan as well as a business plan.

I have attached a copy of the above-mentioned plans together with a layout of the production facility upgrade and expansion project.

I would ask for your Department to consider the proposal which will be managed in two stages.

I also ask that a meeting be convened with yourself and other appropriate Ministers who you consider could be a part of this very exciting project which will be of great benefit to this regional area.
