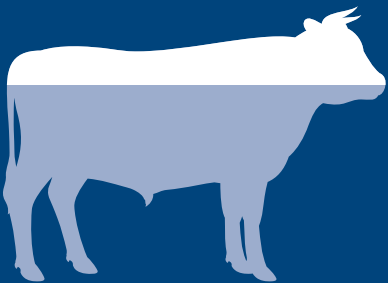
Snapshot

The South Australian dairy industry produced **474 million litres** of milk in 2022-23 from more than **65,000 cows**, bringing around **\$341 million in farm gate revenue**.

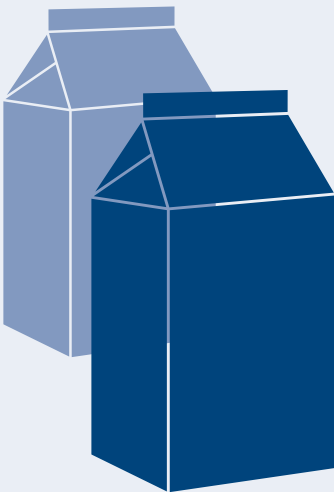
Milk and milk products
