Request meeting to discuss sheep and goat traceability business case preliminary findings

Livestock SA's "Strengthening Sheep and Goat Traceability Project" is nearing the final stages of Phase 1 to produce a business case outlining the benefits, costs, and risks of implementing individual sheep and goat traceability in South Australia.

The consultant ACIL Allen has recently completed state-wide supply chain consultation and has delivered a draft copy of the business case including his findings.

The Sheep and Goat Traceability Steering Committee have recently met to review the draft, and we wish to share the preliminary findings with you in preparation for the Agriculture Ministers Meeting on December 7, 2022. We are hoping your diary allows that opportunity.

We also seek clarification from you and the National Agricultural Ministers on a number of points, to assist our committee in making decisions that are nationally harmonised and focused on the areas that we have influence over.
