



CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP/ ADDRESS FORM

FOR NOTIFYING THE SALE/ PURCHASE OF HIVES, CANCELLATION OF A REGISTRATION OR A CHANGE OF ADDRESS

Under the *Livestock Act 1997*, any person who keeps honeybees, including in hives of any style (incl. nuc/ Top bar/ Warre/ Flow), even if one hive in the backyard, must register annually. Failure to register is an offence - **Max. Penalty \$10,000**.

Under the *Livestock Regulations 2013* a beekeeper must notify the Chief Inspector in writing within 14 days after changing their postal address - **Maximum Penalty \$250**.
