Determination under the Freedom of Information Act 1991

I refer to your application made under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* which was received by the Department of Primary Industries and Regions (PIRSA) on 12 September 2023, seeking access to the following:

"All 'incident reports' and 'near miss reports' related to or from aerial culling teams."

Timeframe: 1/01/2023 to 30/06/2023

On 14 September 2023, PIRSA's Senior Freedom of Information Advisor contacted your office seeking clarification of your application. It was confirmed that your application is referring to all aerial culling teams.

Accordingly, the following determination has been finalised.

I have located two documents that are captured within the scope of your request.

Determination 1

I have determined that access to the following document is granted in part:

The information removed from the above document is pursuant to Clause 4(1)(a) and Clause 6(1) of Schedule 1 of the Freedom of Information Act.

Clause 4(1)(a) states:

"4 - Documents affecting law enforcement and public safety

- (1) A document is an exempt document if it contains matter the disclosure of which could reasonably be expected—
 - (a) to endanger the life or physical safety of any person;"

Clause 6(1) states:

"6 - Documents affecting personal affairs

(1) A document is an exempt document if it contains matter the disclosure of which would involve the unreasonable disclosure of information concerning the personal affairs of any person (living or dead)."

The information removed pursuant to Clause 4(1)(a) and Clause 6(1) consists of:

- location details of an incident event which has been reported during feral deer aerial shooting control operations
- name of officer to whom the event was reported and their email address
- names of individuals
- name of witness
- mobile telephone numbers

Publicising the locations where feral deer could occur could result in illegal hunters accessing properties to illegally hunt the feral deer that are on the properties. In turn, there is a high likelihood that such activity would endanger the life or physical safety of members of the community.

Releasing the names of individuals, email addresses and mobile telephone numbers would identify the properties to which the event refers.

Exposing the names of the officers and witnesses and their telephone numbers to illegal hunters would pose a safety risk to the individuals concerned. Disclosure of this information would be an unreasonable intrusion into the privacy rights of the individuals concerned.

Determination 2

I have determined that access to the following document is granted in part:

The information removed from the above document is pursuant to Clause 4(1)(a), Clause 4(2)(a)(i) and Clause 6(1) of Schedule 1 of the Freedom of Information Act.

The information removed pursuant to Clause 4(1)(a) and Clause 6(1) consists of:

- location details of a hazard event which has been reported during feral deer aerial shooting control operations
- name of officer to whom the event was reported and their email address
- names of individuals
- names of witnesses
- mobile telephone numbers

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Publicising the locations where feral deer could occur could result in illegal hunters accessing properties to illegally hunt the feral deer that are on the properties. In turn, there is a high likelihood that such activity would endanger the life or physical safety of members of the community.

Releasing the names of individuals, email addresses and mobile telephone numbers would identify the properties to which the events refer.

Exposing the names of the officers and witnesses and their telephone numbers to illegal hunters would pose a safety risk to the individuals concerned. Disclosure of this information would be an unreasonable intrusion into the privacy rights of the individuals concerned.

Clause 4(2)(a)(i) states:

"4—Documents affecting law enforcement and public safety

- (2) A document is an exempt document if it contains matter the disclosure of which -
 - (a) could reasonably be expected -
 - to prejudice the investigation of any contravention or possible contravention of the law (including any revenue law) whether generally or in a particular case; and
 - (b) would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest."

The information removed pursuant to Clause 4(2)(a)(i) consists of details outlining the nature of any investigation into the matter.

In addressing the public interest test for the Clause 4 exemption, I have balanced the following factors:

- Meeting the objects of the Act favouring access to documents.
- Ensuring optimal use of public resources.
- High level of interest in the accountability of public office holders.
- The importance of transparency and openness and the interest that the public has in the decision-making processes of Government.
- High level of media and community interest in the matter.

Contrary to the public interest:

- Release of this information is likely to prejudice any investigation into the matter.
- To release such details would provide the public with its own view of the circumstances prior to any investigative outcomes being known.
- It would be inappropriate to disclose information relating to processes leading to any possible wrong-doing, prior to the knowledge of any outcomes.
- A regulator should be able to carry out its legislative functions and investigate matters without fear of the information being prematurely released.
- Should any findings reveal any allegations of wrong-doing, disclosure of this information could reasonably be expected to prejudice the possible contravention of the law.

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Having considered the various factors weighing for and against disclosure, I have determined that disclosure of this information would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest.

If you are dissatisfied with this determination, you are entitled to exercise your right of review and appeal as outlined in the attached documentation <u>Making a Freedom of Information Application | State Records of South Australia (archives.sa.gov.au)</u>, by completing the "FOI Application Form for Internal Review of a Determination" and returning the completed form to:

On Wednesday 22 March Bec Gould sent et al. message saying Claus was thinking of pulling out of the shoot to prove a point to the MLRL board over an issue with MLRL. Bec followed up a phone call with Clause 6(1) . Clause recalls Bec saying Claus was thinking of pulling out not confirming that he was pulling out. On Friday 24 March the '72hr' text messages were sent to all participating landholders advising them of the shoot and to notify us if anything had changed – there was no reply from 6(1) to this message. On the morning of March 28 one aircraft worked Clause property for about 1hrs 20 minutes and shot 17 deer. Claus received a text from Bec via Claus to cease as a worker was in the area.
