Dear Minister

I write to you in support of the Mount Gambier and District Saleyards Upgrade Project and the District Council of Grant's application to the former Commonwealth Government's Building Better Regions Fund Round 6, requesting \$5.3 million.

The Mount Gambier and District Saleyards are located 10 kilometres east of Mount Gambier, are owned and operated by the District Council of Grant. The Saleyards are a key part of the agricultural sector in the Limestone Coast region, generating \$593 million worth of livestock sales over the past five years and providing social and well-being outcomes to the primary producers. In the 2020/21 financial year, the Saleyards facilitated \$125 million worth of livestock (77,000 cattle and 110,000 sheep) sale transactions.

The project is expected to provide transformational change for producers, buyers and transport operators by providing a modern state of the art facility that will be safe, user friendly and attractive to all clients.

The then South Australian Labor Opposition provided a commitment and letter of support in 2021. The new Malinauskas Labor Government has since reaffirmed its commitment of \$2.7 million towards the redevelopment of the saleyards.

This support demonstrates the project is of a high priority for the state of South Australia and I am hopeful that with the Commonwealth Government's support the project can be realised, delivering full benefit to the region's primary producers and the state more broadly.
