Determination under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991*

I refer to your application made under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* (the Act) received by the Office of the Minister for Primary Industries and Regional Development on 31 October 2022 requesting access to the following:

Dear Senator Duniam

Thank you for your correspondence of 25 February 2022 to the former Minister for Primary Industries and Regional Development during the caretaker period, seeking in-principle support to participate in the Support Plantation Establishment Program (the Program).

As this topic now falls within my portfolio as Minister for Forest Industries in the new government, your correspondence has been provided to me for consideration. I am pleased to provide my in-principle support for the Program at this stage subject to further dialogue between our governments and more detailed discussions with my Ministerial colleagues.

The South Australian Government is committed to supporting a sustainable forest industry and seeks to maximise its capacity to produce vital fibre for Australian construction and manufacturing.

It is noted funding is only available to areas covered by the Regional Forestry Hubs. In South Australia this would limit eligibility to the Limestone Coast's share of the Green Triangle.

Clause 1(1)(e)

I look forward to working collaboratively to support the forest industry and help to ensure a sustainable fibre resource is available for the future.
