

ORDER AND SUBMISSION FORM

SUPPLY OF AFB HONEY SAMPLE KITS, SAMPLE DELIVERY, AND AFB HONEY TESTING

Gribbles VETLAB is approved by Biosecurity SA (BSA) to test honey from South Australian registered apiarists for American Foul Brood (AFB) and will arrange:

- supply (if required) of AFB honey sample kits (1x 120 mL container and form in post tube); test cost must be prepaid before kit is supplied
- transport by courier (if required) of honey samples (visit <http://www.clinicallabs.com.au/location> for collection centre locations)
- provision of AFB test reports

A BSA factsheet *Honey Testing*, available at http://www.pir.sa.gov.au/biosecurity/animal_health/bees details the requirements and procedures for collecting and submitting honey samples. Samples must be:

- processed and submitted as detailed in the factsheet
- accompanied with this completed form with correct payment

Prices are GST inclusive, if you require a honey kit to be sent by post, an additional \$15.05 fee applies. Suitable containers are 120ml (min) break-proof and leak-proof (e.g. plastic screw top) containers not previously containing honey. Samples can be dropped at the nearest Australian Clinical Labs collection centre, or delivered to the laboratory at 33 Flemington Street, Glenside. Please note cash cannot be accepted by laboratory staff.

Minimum number of days sample must be submitted prior to date test results are required: Standard fee - 30 days, Priority fee - 7 days. Prepaid - fee must be paid before honey sample kit(s) are sent. All prices are current to 31 March 2019.
